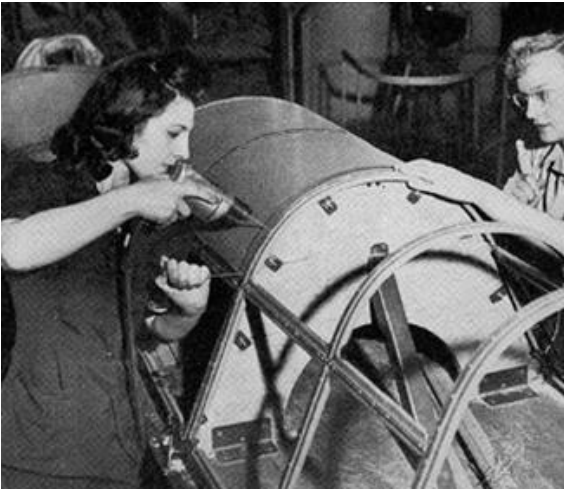

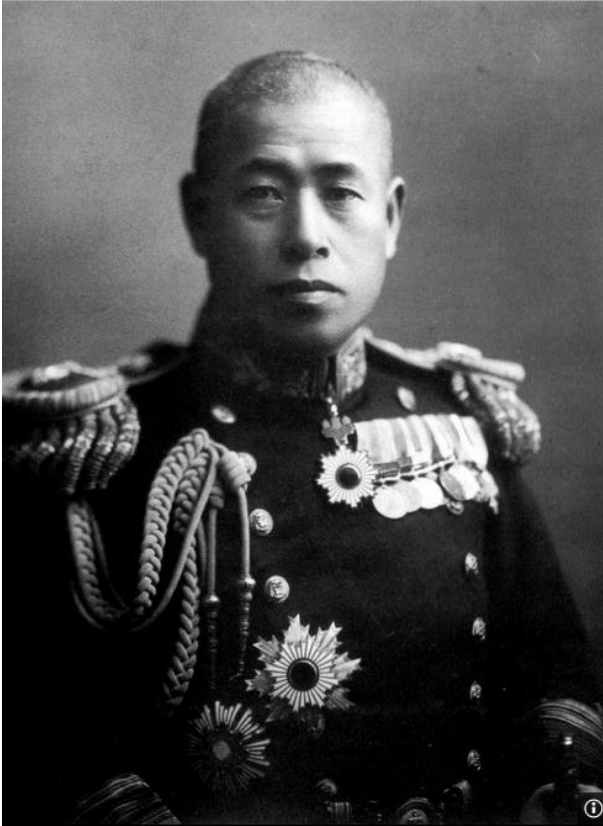


Food rations





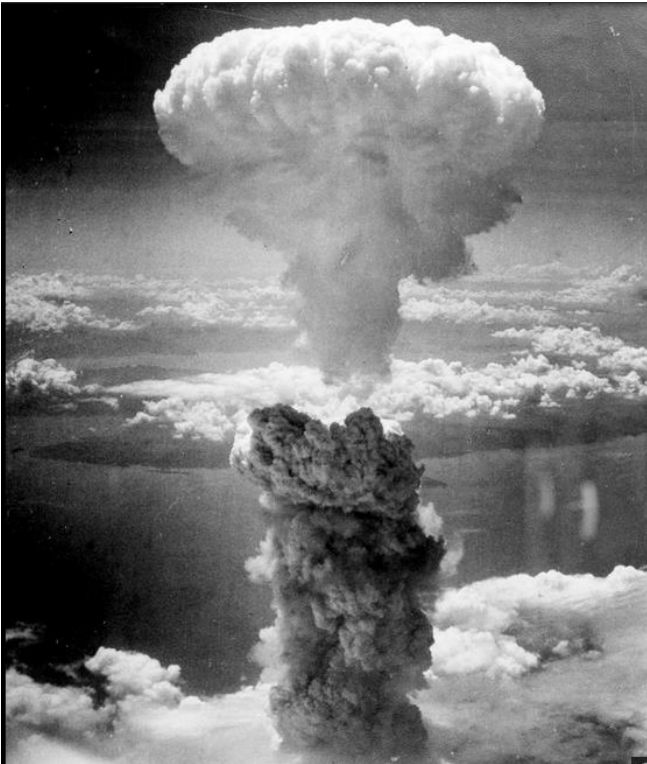
Yamamoto's meaning was that military victory, in a protracted war against an opponent with as much of a population and industrial advantage as the United States possessed, was completely impossible

Nagasaki:

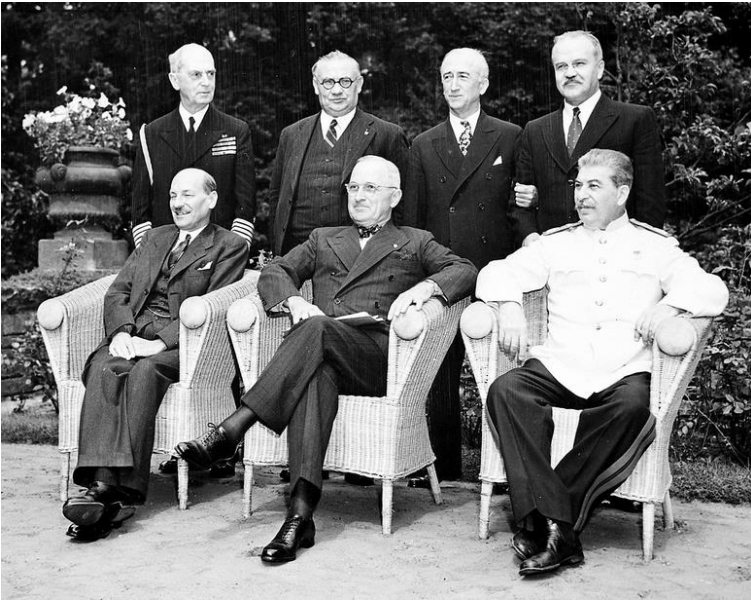
- 39,000–80,000 killed
